Summary of Weather Forecast for next Five days

As per the Weather forecast issued by the India Meteorological Department, Pune and Bengaluru for Dakshina Kannada district, **CHANCE OF DRY WEATHER LIKELY TO BE EXPECTED FOR NEXT FIVE DAYS.** The maximum temperature would be around **34.0°C -35.0°C** and minimum temperature would be around **21.0 °C – 22.0°C** to during next five days. The Morning Relative humidity (RH) would vary from **63-65per cent**, Evening Relative humidity (RH) would vary from **32-35per cent** and wind speed will be in the range of **4-6** km/hr.

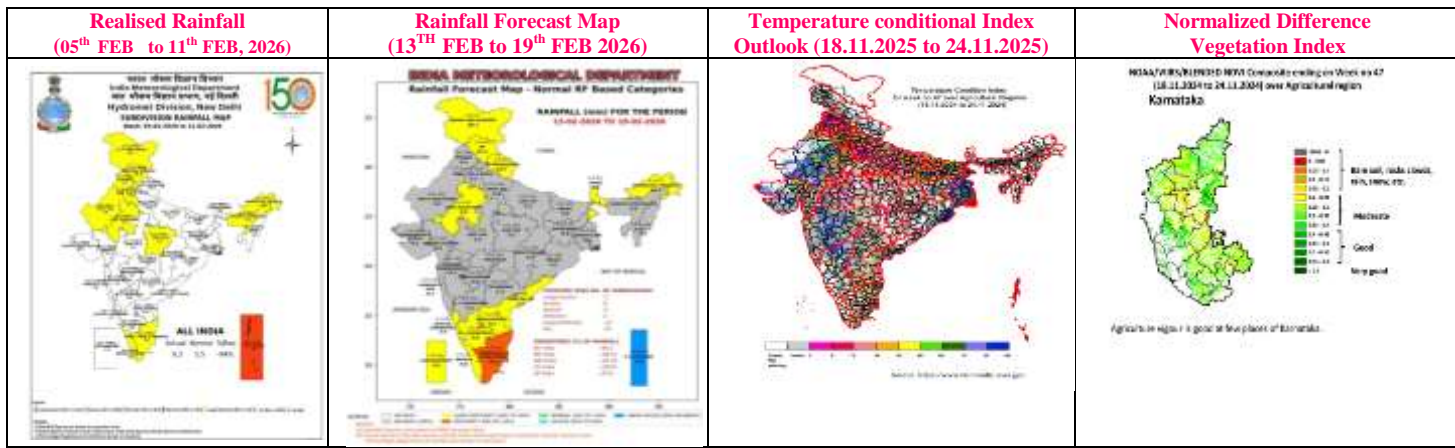

Weather based Agromet Advisories for DAKSHINA KANNADA District

General Advisory:

Chances of Dry Weather may prevail may prevail over the blocks of a district for next 5 days

Farmers can Mulch the root zone of a crop with dried leaves or crop residues to save the moisture or to avoid the loss of water from root zone.

This is a summer time so that farmers can collect Dry waste lying around the farm and they can make compost or vermicompost from that waste.(Sometimes this dry waste may catch a fire & it will cause a huge loss)

Animals should be tied at closed rooms or cattle sheds to protect them from cold and animals that are grazed outside in afternoon hours should be equipped with wet gunny bags over their back to reduce stress due to heat.

Banana	Physiological Maturity	General Advice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5 months After planting spray Banana special @5gm/ltr of water at an interval of 30days or one month.(For one sprayer spray solution add 1 lime and shampoo) • Bunch Treatment: To get good yield & quality bunches treat the bunch with 10 gram of Urea,10 gm of Potassium Sulphate & 0.5kg of cowdung should be mixed with 100ml of water & tie to end of bunch
Black Pepper	Physiological Maturity	General Advice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remove hanging shoots in older plants. • Cover the young vines so as to prevent drying. • Inspect and remove plants showingsymptoms of phyllody and stunt diseases (viral).
Jasmine	Flowering	Pruning	Right time to prune Jasmine plant. Diseased plant parts & dried shoots should be pruned first. Pruned parts should be smeared with 10% Bordo paste
		Leaf Spot	For the Management of leaf spot disease, spray with Hexaconazole @ 1ml/litre of water.
Cashew	Flowering	stem borer	Clean the infected place. After cleaning fill the infected part with Chloropyriphos granules mixed with sand(1:1 ratio)
		Tea Mosquito Bug	Farmers should spray Monocrotophos @ of 1.7ml/ltr or Lamdacyalothrin @ 0.5ml/ltr.

Groundnut	Germination	Agronomic advice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After the primary tillage farmers can till the land with secondary tillage instrument Rotovator. After that based on the moisture availability farmers can take sowing. Earthing up can be done at 15 days,30 days & 45 days for early sown crops.

Livestock:

Cattle (General advise)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Animals should be tied at closed rooms or cattle sheds to protect them from cold. ➤ Cattle-Animals should be vaccinated against FMD, Black Quarter, Enterotoxaemia if not vaccinated earlier. ➤ Balanced feed (Green fodder + dry fodder) should be provided to avoid Acidiosis.
